11 DAY ITINERARY

Qoyllor'ity, the sacred annual pilgrimage to the foot of Mt. Ausangate, is one of the most majestic and colorful festivals in Cusco. Over 50,000 people, from the Andean highlands and beyond, travel during the sixth full moon of each year to pay homage to the stars, revered water sources, and the apus (mountains). Although Qoyllor'ity is known to have begun during the Pre-Inca era, this celebration has evolved into a blend of age-old Andean traditions and Spanish colonial Catholic influences that makes for a truly unique experience.

/ **09:30 am** Begin all-day hike from KM 104 to the Sun Gate at Machu Picchu (picnic lunch en route)

/ **03:00 pm** Walk downhill along the perimeter of the Machu Picchu citadel to catch the shuttle bus to Aguas Calientes

- / **04:00 pm** Scenic sunset drive back to Cusco

Luzclara is a Chilean medicine woman, ‘Great Grandmother’, ceremonial leader, sound healer, and shamanic practitioner who has dedicated her life to the healing of herself, Mother Earth, and all of her beings. For the past 40 years, she has been working on the awakening of sacred feminine energies on the planet by using ancient practices of rituals and magic.

Luzclara has studied and trained with various indigenous shamans around the world including Machi Antonia Lincolaf, a shaman from the Mapuche people of Chile, the Q’ero shamans of Peru, the Quichua Ayahuasca shamans of the Ecuadorian Amazon Jungle and Sun Bear, and the Chippewa Medicine Men in North America—with a focus on uniting the traditions of the collective ‘Americas’. She has also traveled to India and Tibet where she deepened her sound healing techniques.
